

## Get Set For Christmas Placemat Paper Piecing Class Supply List

1. **Sewing Machine** (with owners manual), be sure it is in good working order
2. **Sewing Machine Needles**, size 12 or 14 (bring a few extras)
3. **Thread spool**, 100% cotton, neutral color, and **2 pre-filled bobbins**
4. **Scissors** for cutting fabric & for cutting paper, and **thread snips**
5. **Seam ripper**
6. **Rotary cutter** and **quilters ruler**, for trimming quilt blocks
7. **Flat head pins**, just a few
8. **Wooden Iron** (or Mini Iron, with ironing pad) Wooden iron available at CQ
9. **Get Set For Christmas** pattern by Marjorie Rhine, **6 copies of each ornament pattern**, (must have to take class) trim patterns, leaving ¼” to ½” beyond trimming line (- - - - -)  
Note: Never use original patterns for sewing design and always make all copies on the same copier
10. **Fabrics** - To make it easy for you we have kits available.

If you are choosing your own fabrics keep in mind that your background fabric should be non-directional (muted, marbled, tone-on-tone, nothing distinct in design), there are 12 patches of background fabric circling each ornament design and any busy fabric will detract from your final design. Your ornament fabrics can be anything that you like and directional fabrics will make more interesting designs and show up nicely on your background fabric.

11. **Pre-cut the following fabrics *before class*** (to maximize sewing time in class)

### Background fabric:

Cut 2 strips @ 6 ½” by width of fabric, sub cut into 4 rectangles @ 6 ½” X 15 ½”

Cut 5 strips @ 2” by width of fabric, sub cut 3 strips @ 2” X 4 ½” (24), and  
sub cut 2 strips @ 2” X 3” (24)

Cut 4 strips @ 3” by width of fabric, sub cut @ 3” X 1 ½” (96)

Suggestion: use small baggies for each of the small fabric patches and label

\*It will not be necessary to pre-cut any of your other fabrics before coming to class
